When J Innes (injured) was unable to fulfil his engagement the following substitution was approved.

#### **RACE 1 Stirrups Maiden Handicap 1000m**

Permission was granted for App L Wray to ride **Acedale** claiming only 1 kg of her 2 kg allowance as no other Apprentice riders were available. App Wray was subsequently fined \$150 (LR 70). **Ernie** dislodged its rider en route to the start and galloped a short distance before being recaptured. W Pearson was uninjured. **Ernie** underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to start. **Licence To Kill** underwent a veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the gates and was passed fit to start. **Asp**, **Rebu** and **Ernie** were slow to begin. **Edged In Gold** was slow to begin and shortly after the start was hampered when **Maria Rosa** shifted out. Passing the 600m **Classico Gran Hussy** hung in despite the efforts of its rider resulting in **Ernie** being crowded and making contact with the rail.

#### **RACE 2: Kathy O'Hara Premier Jockey Benchmark 55 Handicap 2300m**

K O'Hara (**Blasphemy**) explained her mount went forward and set a reasonable tempo mid-race however found little when pressured after straightening. A post-race veterinary examination of **Blasphemy** revealed no apparent abnormalities. A post-race veterinary examination of **Regal Instinct** found that gelding to be coughing.

#### **RACE 3: Power Of Destiny Benchmark 65 Handicap 1300m**

**Gusrick** began awkwardly and made contact with the near side gate. M Newnham (**Dance Idol**) explained his mount was obliged to work harder than anticipated to obtain the lead in the early stages and after controlling the tempo mid-race was very

disappointing in its failure to finish the race off. A post-race veterinary examination of **Dance Idol** revealed no apparent abnormalities. Trainer's representative Mr S Dennett subsequently advised stewards that **Dance Idol** would now be spelled.

**RACE 4: Goulburn Wedding & Functions E&G Maiden Plate 1400m**

**Battlers Luck** was slow to begin. N Lye (**Red And Rory**) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding (AR 137(a)) in that after passing the 400m she did direct her mount out when insufficiently clear of **Palasport** which was checked. N Lye's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence after the Bathurst meeting on Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2010, and to expire on Tuesday, 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2010, on which day she may ride

**RACE 5: Goulburn Kia F&M Maiden Plate 1400m**

**Red Hot Lava** began awkwardly, shifted out and hampered **Wind Of Savannah**. **Distant Field** was slow to begin. A Post-race veterinary examination **Kokkei** revealed an elevated heart rate. A post-race veterinary examination of **Fuego** revealed a laceration to its off fore heel. A post-race veterinary examination of **Red Hot Lava** revealed no apparent abnormalities. Trainer Mr P Flood advised stewards that **Distant Field**, which performed poorly, would now be retired from racing.

**RACE 6: Josh Adams Apprentice Jockey Class 1 Handicap 1200m**

**Humblepie Magpie** was slow to begin. **Cleary's Creek** had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the straight.

**RACE 7: Guy Walter Premier Trainer Benchmark 55 Handicap 1600m**

**Foxy Flyer** was slow to begin. App J Collins (**Dr Remlap**) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding (AR 137(a)) in that near the 1200m he did permit his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of **Mrs Menzies** resulting in that runner being taken in across the running of **Prinzaroo** which was checked. **Manu Peru** was also hampered as a consequence. App Collins' permit to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence after the Wagga meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2010, and to expire on Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 2010, on which day he may ride. Near the 1000m **Prinzaroo**, which was overracing, shifted in abruptly when checked away from the heels of **Dr Remlap** resulting in **Danish Belle** being crowded and racing in restricted room for some distance. Trainer Ms C Greig reported following the race that **Dr Remlap** had been galloped on behind.
