Flaperon – slow to begin; near the 500m, improved onto the heels of *Go Rev* and was checked; then shifted out and bumped heavily with *Raine Joy*, which laid in when bumped on the hindquarter; near the 300m, was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of *Raine Joy*, which laid in.

Bendie Boy – slow to begin; raced wide throughout.

Race 3: Benchmark 49 Handicap 1200m:

Bentley Gold – raced wide throughout; steadied near the 250m when *Ibelieveinmiracles* laid out.

Nice One Son – reared on jumping, resulting in rider Ms. K. Chater being badly unbalanced in the saddle.

Bold Suggestion – buffeted near the 1000m between *Ibelieveinmiracles* and *Aussie Bob*, which was taken in by *Flatley's Fortune* (R. Yetimova), which shifted in when not clear. R. Yetimova was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 4: Maiden Handicap 1400m:

Rusty Motorbike – a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any significant abnormalities.

Barakula – raced wide throughout.
