Race 1: 3YO & Up Maiden Plate 1000m

Come into My World – crowded on jumping by *Two 'n' Wellgo* which shifted out.

Manhattan Monty – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Teoagogo – Trainer Mr M Boland was fined \$50 AR59A for failing to have the TIC present on course for the gelding. Mr Boland was advised that *Teoagogo* would not be permitted to race again until he has the TIC in his possession.

Special Strike – late scratching at 12:47pm when it was unable to be loaded into the barriers. Stewards ordered that all bets placed on *Special Strike* be refunded and all successful bets placed on the race with bookmakers be subject to the following deductions.

1st – **Two 'n' Wellgo** – 5 cents win and 6 cents place
2nd – **Shintastic** - 7 cents place
3rd – **Come into My World** – 7 cents place

Trainer Ms K Kennedy was advised that *Special Strike* would be required to barrier to the satisfaction of stewards before being permitted to race again.

Tellmay – A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the right hind leg. Trainer Mr N McCarthy was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required before the mare is permitted to race again.

Race 2: Benchmark 50 Handicap Div (1) 1100m

Orlando Jack – Steadied near the 800m when awkwardly placed on the heels of *Carmel*.

Security Code – Began awkwardly. Raced wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be displaying a poor post race recovery.

Tully Ho – Slow to begin.

Whispadah – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 3: Benchmark 50 Handicap Div (2) 1100m

Bel Attrait – Slow to begin.

Milagre Da Vida – A pre race veterinary examination passed the mare fit to start.

Flying By – A post race veterinary examination of the mare which competed at Bathurst on Friday 18th August passed the mare fit to start.

Slickster – Correct weight was delayed whilst rider Ms L Henry viewed the photo of the finish of the race. As she was satisfied with the judges placing's, correct weight was declared.

Race 4: 3YO & Up Maiden Handicap 1200m:

This race was delayed for some time due to the ambulance being required to treat a patron on course.

Thirteen Black – Bumped heavily with *Cheeky Charlie* on jumping and became unbalanced losing ground. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Wanted Trio – Rider R Yetimova accidentally dropped his whip passing the 500m.

Cheeky Charlie – bumped on jumping becoming unbalanced and losing ground.

Divine Nature – Slow to begin.

Mary Thinks – Hung out rounding the home turn and lost ground.

Nino – When questioned apprentice Ms C Ings stated that her mount travelled only fairly in the early and middle stages and when placed under pressure felt flat and found little in the straight. A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5: Benchmark 50 Handicap 1600m:

Ima Baker – Hung out passing the 1400m.

Jesse 'n' James – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Didyahearme – Slow to begin. Hung out in the early stages.

Race 6: Benchmark 60 Handicap 1300m:

Cool Rules – Hung out passing the 300m.

Rusty Motorbike – Slow to begin.

Real Blonde – Slow to begin.

John D'Non – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Fairy Fragments – Steadied near the 250m when awkwardly placed on the heels of *Prettylittlefellow*. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 7: Benchmark 50 Handicap 800m

Clever Buttons – Shifted out passing the 200m and momentarily hampered Black Comedy.

Hidden Chief – Trainer Mr B T Dixon was advised that a warning would be recorded against the record of the gelding after it was fractious in the barriers and delayed the start. Slow to begin.

New Player – Slow to begin.
