Race 1: Maiden Handicap 1400m

Kemp – raced ungenerously for some distance passing the 900m.

Race 2: Maiden Plate 1100m

Nobody – raced fiercely during the middle stages.

Justflickinit – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding displayed a poor recovery with mild heat stress. Justflickinit was treated and monitored by the clubs veterinary officer.

Only A Whisper – slow to begin.

Invincible Light – the saddle slipped backwards significantly passing the 900m which placed the rider, J Penza at an extreme disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

Old Friends – raced fiercely during the middle stages, and then hung in when placed under pressure in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly was lame in the off hind leg. Stable representative Mr. S Perry was advised that prior to racing again Old Friends would be required to undergo a veterinary examination to determine its fitness.

Race 3: 3YO Maiden Plate 900m

Charlatan – slow to begin.

Nevada Mo – slow to begin.

Tale Of Eight – began very awkwardly and shifted out abruptly.

Lady Segolene – broke through the barrier prior to a start being effected, however was quickly retrained and returned to the start were it was passed by the clubs veterinary officer.

Race 4: Class 1 Plate 1600m

Pencita – slow to begin. The rider J Van Overmeire was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts in at least hands and heels fashion to the end of every race wherever possible.

Cunning As A Tiger – slow to begin.

Lucky Show – slow to begin.

Solid North – hung in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

Race 5: Benchmark 55 Handicap 1100m

Wide Eyed – bounded at the start, and then shifted out abruptly resulting in J Penza almost being dislodged.

Natadola – slow to begin.

Loading – slow to begin.

Race 6: Class 3 Handicap 1300m

Laszlo – shifted in when placed under pressure when racing ungenerously passing the 300m, then hung in when placed under pressure inside the 200m.

Not For Export – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

Lethal – slow to begin.

Race 7: Class 1 Handicap 900m

Magic Beneteau – hung in under pressure inside the 200m.

Ladwell – slow to begin, then raced in restricted room for some distance in the early part of the home straight.

Black Comedy – had to be checked near the 40m when crowded between All Art which shifted out slightly under pressure and Magic Beneteau which shifted in marginally.

All Aflutter – slow to begin, then became unbalanced passing the 250m, shifted out abruptly and hung out under pressure from that point.
