

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – NSW PARTICIPANTS

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS – ATTENDANCE OF OWNERS

- In the metropolitan area, owners are required to pre-book attendance at the Race Club to see their horses race, including providing contact details by way of phone number or email address. In the provincial and country regions, prebooking is not compulsory but contact details (phone number or email) must be obtained in respect of all owners attending.
- Owners cannot book in individual groups of more than 20 and no more than 20 owners are allowed per horse.
- Designated areas will be allocated for Owners throughout the racecourse with individual groups to be no more than 20 persons and no co-mingling between individual groups.
- Owners are permitted to view their horse in the raceday stalls (separated by fencing) with the restrictions on individual groups being no more than 20 persons to apply and no co-mingling between individual groups.
- Owners are not permitted to enter the mounting enclosure or communicate with their jockey.
- Owners are permitted to attend to watch their horse race and leave the racecourse 30 minutes after the race has concluded.
- Any seating will be modified to support 1.5 metres of social distancing and, where appropriate, floor markings to reduce crowding and promote physical distancing.
- Race Clubs are to engage appropriate numbers of Social Distancing Officers to enforce the above.
- Owners and Race Clubs continue to abide by existing COVID-19 Protocols including social distancing of 1.5 metres, sufficient space for one person per 4 square metres, good hygiene practices at all times and unwell persons not to be permitted access to racecourses. Race Club staff are to be provided with information and training on COVID-19, including when to get tested, physical distancing and cleaning.
