



COVID-19 Update

Friday, 8 January 2021

Racing NSW has taken further expert advice and the following protocols are currently in place to manage stay at home orders issued by the NSW and Queensland Governments while contact tracers work to ensure the UK strain of COVID-19 is not circulating in the community. These protocols must be read in conjunction with recent releases made by Racing NSW.

Queensland Local Government Areas of Brisbane, Moreton Bay, Ipswich, Redlands and Logan

Persons who reside in or who have attended after 12:01am on 2 January 2021 (and returned to NSW) the **Queensland local government areas of Brisbane, Moreton Bay, Ipswich, Redlands and Logan** are not permitted to attend racecourses or licensed premises until 6pm on 11 January 2021 (or as further advised by Racing NSW) and must provide Racing NSW with the results of a negative COVID-19 test prior to attending a NSW racecourse or licensed premises.

Industry participants who attend the Ipswich race meeting scheduled to be conducted on Saturday, 9 January 2021 are advised that should they elect to attend this race meeting, they shall be subject to the Stay at Home orders and be required to provide Racing NSW with a negative COVID-19 test result prior to entering a racecourse or licensed premises after 6pm on 11 January 2021 (or any other time determined by Racing NSW).
