Racing NSW has taken further expert advice with respect to the protocols in place to manage the COVID-19 cluster in Queensland.

Greater Brisbane Area and Grand Chancellor Hotel - Brisbane

Essential Personnel (Including race club employees) who reside in or have attended after 12.01am on 2 January 2021, the **Queensland Local Government Areas of Brisbane, Moreton Bay, Ipswich, Redlands and Logan** are not permitted to attend licensed racecourses or licensed premises until such time as they have provided Racing NSW with the results of a negative COVID-19 test prior to attending a NSW Racecourse or licensed premises.

General Public who resides in or have attended after 12.01am on 2 January 2021, the **Queensland Local Government Areas of Brisbane, Moreton Bay, Ipswich, Redlands and Logan** are now permitted to attend NSW racecourses and licensed premises without having to obtain a negative COVID-19 test, subject to that person not having attended a location or travelled on transport identified by the NSW Government as being a close or casual contact to COVID-19 in the link below.
