“He’s a genuine all-rounder type who gives everything a go and thrives on having a job to do.

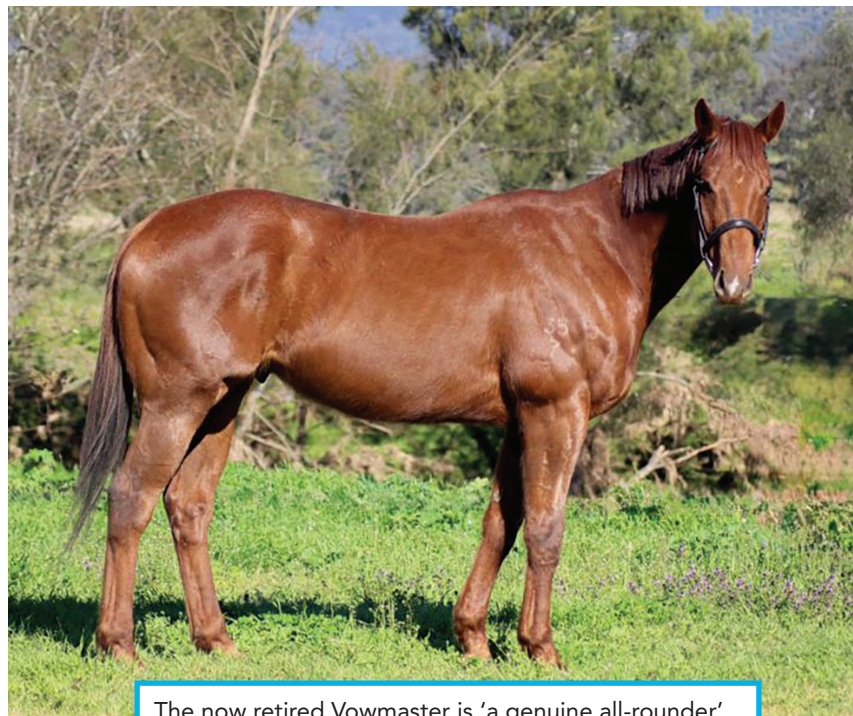
