



NOTICE – BORDER RESIDENTS

Friday, 18 September 2020

Racing NSW today has announced the introduction of the easing of restrictions applying to residents of the border region of NSW and Victoria (approximately 50km either side of the border).

The easing of restrictions by Racing NSW is consistent with the advice it has received from its biosecurity expert that it is appropriate to review its position given the reduction in the amount of daily new cases and the stabilisation of the infection rate in Victoria. It is also in line with the most recent easing of restrictions by the NSW Government.

Effective immediately:

1. Victorian residents who currently reside in the border region (see attached map) can attend NSW licensed premises and racecourse, but only within the border region, upon provision of a signed declaration that they have not travelled to an area of Victoria outside the border region or an area that is a COVID-19 concern within the previous 21 days;
2. NSW residents who currently reside in the border region can travel within the border region (including Victoria) and may also travel outside the border area within NSW and attend any NSW licensed premises or racecourse, upon provision of a signed declaration that they have not travelled to an area of Victoria outside the border region or an area that is a COVID-19 concern within the previous 21 days;
3. Any person who resides in the border region (either a NSW or Victorian resident) and has been in an area of Victoria outside the border region or an area that is a COVID-19 concern within the previous 21 days, must not enter a NSW licensed premises or racecourse.
